RESOLUTION NO. 4853

A RESOLUTION regarding the position of the City of Bellevue on the use of certain chemicals to control aquatic vegetation; and repealing Resolution No. 3755.

WHEREAS, on May 18, 1981, the City Council enacted Resolution No. 3755, in which the Council stated its opposition to the use of chemicals to control aquatic vegetation; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 1987, the City Council voted to terminate its position stated in Resolution No. 3755; and


WHEREAS, the City Council desires to implement this determination by repealing Resolution No. 3755; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Resolution No. 3755, opposing the use of chemicals to control aquatic vegetation, is hereby repealed.
