RESOLUTION NO. 5291

A RESOLUTION adopting the Factoria Subarea Action Plan.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a new Factoria Subarea Plan of the Subarea Element of the Comprehensive Plan for the development of the City of Bellevue pursuant to Resolution No. 5290; and

WHEREAS, an Action Plan was developed for the Factoria Subarea Plan to implement policies in the plan and to take the place of the existing Implementation Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Action Plan is to set forth the action required to implement a policy and to identify the responsible department and time frame for completion of the action and to state whether the proposed action has been funded; and

WHEREAS, the Action Plan identifies and recommends proposals and actions that may not currently be funded by the City; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the Action Plan does not represent a precommitment by the City Council of resources for the funding of such proposals and actions; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that resource requests for those proposals recommended to be acted on in the Action Plan will be brought forward for appropriate budgetary consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Action Plan is intended to be a dynamic document that will help the City be more responsive to community concerns; and

WHEREAS, it is intended that the Action Plan be reviewed by staff every six months to update the status of projects and reevaluate priorities; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommends adoption of the Factoria Subarea Action Plan; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That certain "Factoria Subarea Action Plan," a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 15744, is hereby adopted.
