RESOLUTION NO. 5328

A RESOLUTION establishing the City of Bellevue legislative program for the 1991 legislative session.

WHEREAS, the purpose of city government is to provide the highest level of service to its citizens in the most efficient and effective manner possible; and

WHEREAS, cities in Washington are subject to state legislative action; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue believes that local government can be the most effective level of government if given the opportunity and should be given the authority to make decisions which are primarily local in nature; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue City Council wishes to communicate its legislative priorities to members of the Washington State Legislature; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Favorable consideration by the Washington State Legislature of the issues identified in the Legislative Agenda for 1991, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 16022, will enable the City to more effectively serve its residents. Therefore, the Legislative Agenda for 1991 is hereby adopted.

Section 2. The Legislative Agenda for 1991 shall be conveyed to the appropriate members of the Washington State Legislature and shall form the basis for City of Bellevue communications with state legislators during the 1991 legislative session.
