RESOLUTION NO. 5414

A RESOLUTION authorizing the execution of an interlocal agreement among the Cities of Bellevue, Kirkland, and Redmond to create a joint transportation modeling project.

WHEREAS, using state-of-the-art computer software and highly-trained staff, the City of Bellevue has developed a highly-sophisticated transportation model and is able to analyze the potential traffic impact of development and transportation plans on city streets; and

WHEREAS, Bellevue's use of the traffic model is limited if we cannot easily exchange information with neighboring jurisdictions because of different data bases and traffic modeling approaches; and


WHEREAS, Transportation Forecast Model Development and Maintenance Program would expand Bellevue's transportation modeling approach to the Cities of Kirkland and Redmond and the Interlocal Agreement would allow Kirkland and Redmond to use Bellevue's computer software through terminals in their respective City offices; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the City, that certain Interlocal Agreement with Kirkland and Redmond, a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 16837.
