RESOLUTION NO. 5416

A RESOLUTION supporting the enhanced 9-1-1 statewide referendum on the November 1991 ballot.

WHEREAS, Enhanced 9-1-1 is an emergency telephone communication system for rapidly accessing the appropriate emergency telephone communication system; and

WHEREAS, Enhanced 9-1-1 is not available to all of the citizens of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bellevue, Washington, recognizes the mobility of the citizens of the City of Bellevue and the State of Washington and the need for a universal emergency services contact telephone number to provide for those citizens; and


WHEREAS, 9-1-1 is an easily recognizable and universal emergency telephone number; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, hereby supports the Enhanced 9-1-1 statewide referendum on the November 1991 ballot.
