RESOLUTION NO. 6371

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for a hearing to consider a petition to vacate a portion of NE 15th Street from 290 feet east of 112th Avenue NE to I-405.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A public hearing shall be had on December 6, 1999 at the hour of 8:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 11511 Main Street, Bellevue, Washington, upon a petition to vacate right-of-way of the property owners of over two thirds of land abutting NE 15th Street, described as follows:

That portion of a 60.00 foot right-of-way known as N.E. 15th Street adjoining Lot 5, Burroughs' Eastside Addition, according to the plat thereof, recorded in Volume 44 of Plats, page 84, Records of King County, Washington;


Together with that portion of said N.E. 15th Street adjoining that portion of Lot 6 of Burroughs' Eastside Addition, lying Westerly of SR-405.

Section 2. Notice of such hearing shall be posted in the manner required by Bellevue Land Use Code, Section 20.30L.125 inviting interested persons to appear and be heard for or against the proposed vacation.

Section 3. The matter is referred to the City Manager for investigation and report, as necessary at said public hearing.
