

RESOLUTION NO. 658

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing on a petition to vacate a portion of S.E.

28th Place within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of interested property owners for the vacation of a portion of _____

S. E. 28th Place in the City of Bellevue lying

in Brennan's Enatai Gardens No. 2, cul, de sac to be 80 feet diameter; center of cul de sac to be located 470 feet East of the center line of 110th Ave. S.E.

on the 26th day of July, 1955 at the hour of 8:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the Council at the City Hall in the V. F. W. Building on the corner of Main Street and 100th Avenue S. E.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
