

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing on a petition to vacate a portion of _____

KILLARNEY DRIVE within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of interested property owners for the vacation of a portion of _____

KILLARNEY DRIVE in the City of Bellevue lying All that portion of Killarney Drive, as the same was dedicated in the plat of Killarney, according to the plat thereof recorded in volume 24 of plats, page 24, records of King County, Washington, lying south-westerly of the following described line:

Beginning at the most easterly corner of lot 3, block 2 of said plat; thence northwesterly along the northeasterly line of said lot 3, 70.00 feet to the true point of beginning; thence north $45^{\circ} 43'00''$ west 45.362 feet to a point of curve; thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 405.003 feet, the radial center of said curve bearing north $44^{\circ} 17'00''$ east an arc distance of 155.973 feet to the terminus of said line at a point in the northeasterly line of lot 4, block 1 of said plat, distant 39.28 feet south $23^{\circ} 39'04''$ east from the north-east corner thereof.

on the 26th day of July, 1955 at the hour of 8:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the Council at the City Hall in the V. F. W. Building on the corner of Main Street and 100th Avenue S. E.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
