


RESOLUTION NO. 666

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue:

1. That the City Council is in favor of an overall comprehensive plan for the entire East Side; and we urge the County Commissioners to complete their survey and suggested plan as soon as possible looking toward its final adoption at the earliest possible date.

2. It is our belief that the best interest of the East Side area can be served by the Commissioners' action in withholding any land use reclassification until such time, in the development of the East Side comprehensive plan, that such reclassification will not be inconsistent with said plan.


