

RESOLUTION NO. 673

A RESOLUTION, amending Resolution No. 668 adopted the 27th day of March, 1956, and setting a new time and place for hearing thereon.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Resolution No. 668, passed the 27th day of March, 1956, declaring the intention of the City Council to order a local improvement for the construction of storm drain sewers, catch basins and related improvements, setting forth the nature and extent thereof, setting a date for hearing objections and giving notice thereof, is ^{amended} to provide as follows:

"(2) All persons who may desire to object to the formation of the proposed Enlarged Local Improvement District are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council, or a Committee thereof, to be held in the Council Chambers, in the V. F. W. Building in the City of Bellevue at 8:00 o'clock P. M., on the 24th day of July, 1956, which time and place is hereby fixed for a continued hearing of all matters relating to the proposed improvement and all objections thereto and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

"All persons desiring to present objections at said meeting shall file such objection in writing with the clerk of the city before said meeting. The written protest must be signed by the objector, must clearly state the grounds of objection and must identify the objector's property within the proposed Enlarged Local Improvement District."

Section 2. Written objections heretofore filed with the City Clerk to the formation of the Enlarged Local Improvement District as proposed by the petition of owners of property therein, filed with the City Clerk on the 28th day of ^{March} 1956, the territorial extent of which is described in the City Council's Resolution No. 668, a copy of which was published in the Bellevue American on the 12th and 19th days of April, 1956, together with all new or additional objections filed prior to 8:00 o'clock P. M., on the 24th day of July, 1956, will be considered by the City Council at the continued hearing on said Resolution No. 668 on July 24, 1956
