

RESOLUTION NO. 677

A RESOLUTION, declaring intention to order a local improvement for acquisition of land for location and establishment of streets, setting forth the nature and extent thereof, giving notice thereof.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the City Council to order the improvement of an area within the city described as:

Beginning at the North  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 32, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; thence South along the centerline of 108th Avenue N.E. to its intersection with the Easterly extension of the North line of the South half of Lot 3, Block 2, Cheriton Fruit Gardens which is the true point of beginning; thence West along said North line to the West line of said Lot 3; thence West along the North line of the South half of Lot 4, Block 2, Cheriton Fruit Gardens to the centerline of 104th Avenue N.E.; thence South along said centerline of 104th Avenue N.E. to its intersection with the Westerly extension of the South line of the North half of Lot 1, Block 3, Cheriton Fruit Gardens; thence East along said South line to the centerline of 106th Avenue N.E.; thence East along the South line of the North half of Lot 2, Block 3, Cheriton Fruit Garden to the centerline of 108th Avenue N.E.; thence North along the centerline of 108th Avenue N.E. to the true point of beginning. Said Cheriton Fruit Gardens being recorded in Volume 7 of Plats, Page 47, records of King County, Washington,

by acquiring land for right-of-way, doing original grading, surfacing, filling, compacting, and improving the surface by paving the same with asphaltic concrete paving, including provisions for necessary drainage, ballasting and the constructing of curbs or aprons, and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, all in accordance with plans and specifications to be submitted by the City Engineer on the following described street:

Northeast 4th: 60' Right-of-Way approximately 1320' long between the Easterly margin of 104th Avenue N.E. and Westerly margin of 108th Avenue N.E.

All according to the map of the City Engineer.

Section 2. That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council, or a committee thereof, to be held in the Council Chamber in the V.F.W. Building in the City of Bellevue at 8:00 o'clock p.m., on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1956, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said proposed improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement. All persons desiring to be heard at said meeting shall file such objection in writing with the Clerk of the City before said meeting. The protest must be signed by the objector, must clearly state the grounds of objection, and must identify the objector's property within the proposed district.

Section 3. That the City Manager shall submit to the City Council, at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.

Section 4. That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property liable therefor, as provided by law.
