## RESOLUTION NO. 685

A RESOLUTION, directing and authorizing the City Manager and City Attorney to negotiate with property owners for the acquisition of a strip of land 13½ feet wide on either side of N.E. Fourth Street between 104th and 108th Avenues, N.E., for street purposes, and providing for the condemnation of such land in the event it cannot be acquired for the reasonable value thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Manager and City Attorney be directed and authorized to negotiate with property owners for the purpose of acquiring a strip of land thirteen and one-half  $(13\frac{1}{2})$  feet wide on either side of N.E. Fourth Street between 104th and 108th Avenues, N.E., for street purposes.

Section 2. That in the event such property cannot be acquired for the reasonable value thereof, proceedings be taken under Chapter 8.12, R. C. W., for the condemnation of such land. The costs of such acquisition and improvement shall be paid wholly by special assessment upon the property benefited.
