

RESOLUTION NO. 686

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing on a petition to vacate a portion of _____

S. E. Tenth Street within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of interested property owners for the vacation of a portion of _____

S. E. Tenth Street in the City of Bellevue lying

as follows:

That portion of said S.E. 10th Street lying between the East margin of 100th Avenue, S.E. and the West margin of 101st Avenue, S.E., AND that portion of said S.E. 10th Street lying between the East margin of 101st Avenue, S.E. and the West margin of Grant (Allen) Avenue, S.E.

on the 7th day of January, 19 57 at the hour of 8:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the Council at the City Hall in the V. F. W. Building on the corner of Main Street and 100th Avenue S. E.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
