

RESOLUTION NO. 689


A RESOLUTION, rejecting the claims of Percy and Esther Grange against the City of Bellevue, filed with the City Clerk on the 4th and 5th days of October, 1956, respectively.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO RESOLVE
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the claim of Percy and Esther Grange, residing at 100th Avenue Southeast, Bellevue, Washington, filed with the City Clerk on the 4th day of October, 1956, for damages alleged to have arisen from the removal of screening by the cutting of trees on the front section of Lot 4, Block 6, Lochleven, be, and hereby is, rejected.

Section 2. That the claim of Percy and Esther Grange, residing at 100th Avenue Southeast, Bellevue, Washington, filed with the City Clerk on the 5th day of October, 1956, for damages alleged to have resulted from the posting of a stop work order issued by the Building Inspector be, and hereby is, rejected.
