

RESOLUTION NO. 693


A RESOLUTION relating to local excise taxes.

WHEREAS, the state-shared excises and the existing means available to cities for raising additional revenue are inadequate to bear the cost of furnishing necessary municipal services and of discharging all other fiscal and governmental obligations and expenses imposed upon cities and towns, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


That the City Council of the City of Bellevue does favor the enactment of permissive legislation by the Washington State Legislature granting authority to the cities and towns of this state to impose a local excise tax of a character similar to the sales tax now collected by the State Tax Commission.
