RESOLUTION NO. 694

A RESOLUTION, supporting and urging the passage of the Metropolitan Council Act, Senate Bill No. 136.

WHEREAS, the need is apparent for the creation of machinery to provide the solution to metropolitan area-wide problems beyond the ability of individual cities and counties to solve for themselves; and

WHEREAS, the Seattle metropolitan area is in serious jeopardy in the welfare of its community for lack of such permissive legislation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue is vitally interested in serious pollution conditions as they exist in Lake Washington and their adverse effect on the community; and

WHEREAS, it will only be a matter of time before other populated areas within our state experience the same problems and conditions; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the City of Bellevue, in the best interest of its citizens and the area at large, pray that permissive legislation be enacted to provide for a metropolitan government, and strongly urge all legislative support of the Metropolitan Council Act, Senate Bill No. 136, to insure its passage.
