

RESOLUTION NO. 698

A RESOLUTION, accepting deeds of dedication from Charles Frankle and Hilda Frankle, his wife, and Robert E. Bothell, Jr., and Evelyn S. Bothell, his wife, to a right-of-way for Southeast 14th Street.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the deed of dedication dated January 29, 1957, wherein Charles Frankle and Hilda Frankle are grantors and the City of Bellevue is grantee to a strip of land described as:

The North thirty (30) feet of the following described property lying in the County of King, State of Washington: Beginning on the South Line of the North half of the South half of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 5, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., 89.10 feet West of the Intersection with the West line of Lake Washington Boulevard; thence East to said Boulevard; thence North along the West line of said Boulevard to a point 165 feet South of the North line of said subdivision; thence West 79.60 feet; thence South to the point of beginning,

for street purposes is hereby accepted, and directed to be recorded with the Auditor of King County.

Section 2. That the deed of dedication dated February 1, 1957, wherein Robert E. Bothell, Jr., and Evelyn S. Bothell are grantors and the City of Bellevue is grantee to a strip of land described as:

The North thirty (30) feet of that portion of the North half of the South half of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 5, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of the West 390 feet of said subdivision; thence South $88^{\circ}30'39''$ East along the southerly line of said subdivision 89 feet to a point 266.18 feet westerly of the intersection of said southerly line with the westerly line of Lake Washington Boulevard; thence North $2^{\circ}23'40''$ West to the southerly line of the North 165 feet of said subdivision; thence North $88^{\circ}30'21.5''$ West along said southerly line to the easterly line of the West 390 feet of said subdivision; thence South $1^{\circ}25'46''$ West 164.9 feet to the point of beginning,

for street purposes is hereby accepted and directed to be recorded with the Auditor of King County.
