A RESOLUTION, accepting deed of dedication from George Powell and Catherine B. Powell, his wife, to right-of-way for Southeast Fourteenth Street.


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the deed of dedication dated March 20, 1957, wherein George Powell and Catherine B. Powell are grantors and the City of Bellevue is grantee to a strip of land described as:

A portion of the North one-half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of the South one-half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 5, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M. situated in the County of King, State of Washington, to-wit: The North thirty (30) feet of the following described property: Beginning on the South line of said subdivision at a point 177.18 feet westerly of intersection of South line with the West line of Lake Washington Boulevard; thence North $88^{\circ}30'39''$ West along South Line 89.00 feet; thence North $2^{\circ}23'40''$ West to South line of North 165 feet of said subdivision; thence South $88^{\circ}30'21\frac{1}{2}''$ East along said South line to point from the point of beginning which bears South $06^{\circ}11'45''$ East; thence South $6^{\circ}11'45''$ East to the point of beginning,

for street purposes is hereby accepted, and directed to be recorded with the Auditor of King County.
