

RESOLUTION NO. 701

A RESOLUTION, declaring intention to order a local improvement for location and establishment of a street, setting forth the nature and extent thereof, setting a date for hearing objections and giving notice thereof.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the City Council to order the improvement of an area within the City of Bellevue, described as:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerlines of 124th Avenue N.E. and vacated McDermott Street (also known as N.E. 14th Street) as recorded in the Plat of Brierwood Park Volume 17 of Plats page 18 Records of King County; thence westerly along the centerline of said vacated McDermott Street 120 feet more or less; thence southerly parallel to 120 feet from the centerline of 124th Avenue N.E. (also known as the north-south centerline of Section 28, Township 25, North Range 5 East W. M.) to the centerline of the Bellevue-Redmond Highway; thence northeasterly along said centerline to its intersection with a perpendicular line from the centerline of 124th Avenue N.E. and 120 feet east of said centerline; thence northerly parallel to and 120 feet from the centerline of 124th Avenue N.E. to the northerly line of N.E. 14th Street; thence westerly along said northerly line to the point of beginning.

By accomplishing the original grading, re-grading, filling, compacting, surfacing and improving the surface of said street by paving the same with bituminous or Portland cement concrete paving, including provisions for necessary drainage, ballasting and the constructing of curbs or aprons, and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, all in accordance with plans and specifications to be submitted by the City Engineer on the following described streets:

124th Avenue N.E. extending north from the northerly margin of the Bellevue-Redmond Highway to the centerline of N.E. 14th Street a distance of approximately 900 feet.

All according to the map of the City Engineer.


Section 2. That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council, or a committee thereof, to be held in the Council Chamber in the V.F.W. Building in the City of Bellevue, Washington, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., on the

25th day of June, 1957, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said proposed improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

Section 3. That the City Manager shall submit to the City Council at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.


Section 4. That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property liable therefor, as provided by law.
