

RESOLUTION NO. 707

A RESOLUTION, accepting a petition for annexation, filed with the Clerk on the 6th day of August, 1957, under Receiving No. 185, fixing a time and place for hearing upon said petition, directing that determination be made of the legal sufficiency thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the petition for annexation filed with the City Clerk on the 6th day of August, 1957, under Receiving No. 185, is accepted.

Section 2. That a public hearing be had upon said petition on the 24 day of September, 1957, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the Council, at the City Hall in the V. F. W. Building, 10017 Main Street, Bellevue, Washington.

Section 3. That notice of such hearing be published and posted in the manner required by law inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing to speak for or against the granting of said petition.


Section 4. That the City Manager is directed to cause determination to be made of the legal sufficiency of said petition.
