A RESOLUTION authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute, on behalf of the City, an agreement with HDR Engineering, Inc., for technical analysis services in support of long-range transportation planning for the greater Overlake Hospital area, and revising the 2003-2009 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan by increasing the budget for I-405 Access Design Options, CIP Plan No. PW-R-148, by \$115,451 through the transfer of \$100,000 in federal Transportation and Community System Preservation funds from NE 10th Street Extension, CIP Plan No. PW-R-149, and \$15,451 in General CIP funds from Transportation Planning Studies, CIP Plan No. PW-R-44.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, that certain Agreement with HDR Engineering, Inc., for technical analysis services in support of long-range transportation planning for the greater Overlake Hospital area, given Clerk's Receiving No. 36692.

Section 2. The 2003-2009 Capital Investment Program Plan is hereby amended to increase the budget for CIP Plan No. PW-R-148, I-405 Access Design Options Plan, by \$115,451, in part, through the transfer of \$100,000 in federal Transportation and Community System Preservation funds from NE 10th Street Extension, CIP Plan No. PW-R-149.

Section 3. The 2003-2009 Capital Investment Program Plan is hereby revised to increase the budget for CIP Plan No. PW-R-148, I-405 Access Design Options Plan, by \$115,451, in part, through the transfer of \$15,451 in General CIP funds from Transportation Planning Studies.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
