RESOLUTION NO. 7148

A RESOLUTION adopting the City of Bellevue Federal  
Legislative Agenda for the 2005 legislative session.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the city government is to provide high quality  
service to its citizens in the most efficient and effective manner possible; and

WHEREAS, cities in Washington are subject to federal legislative action; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue believes that local government can be the  
most effective level of government if given the opportunity and should be given the  
authority to make decisions which are primarily local in nature; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue City Council wishes to communicate its legislative  
priorities to the members of the United States Congress; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES  
RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Favorable legislation by the United States Congress of the issues  
identified in the Federal Legislative Agenda for 2005, a copy of which has been  
given Clerk's Receiving No. 37205, will enable the City of Bellevue to more  
effectively serve its residents. Therefore, the Federal Legislative Agenda is hereby  
adopted.

Section 2. The Federal Legislative Agenda for 2005 shall be conveyed to the  
appropriate members of the United States Congress and shall form the basis for City  
of Bellevue communications concerning federal issues in 2005.
