## RESOLUTION NO. 7155

A RESOLUTION initiating vacation of N.E. 9th Street, between 106<sup>th</sup> Avenue N.E. and 108<sup>th</sup> Avenue N.E.; and setting a time and place for a hearing to consider such a vacation.

WHEREAS, the City Council received a petition to initiate the vacation of a certain City right-of-way set forth in Section 1 herein and desires to set a time and place for a hearing before the City Council to consider such vacation; now therefore.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby initiates the vacation, pursuant to section 14.35.030 of the Bellevue City Code, of the following City right-of-way, as more particularly described in Attachment A:

N.E. 9<sup>th</sup> Street, between 106<sup>th</sup> Avenue N.E. and 108<sup>th</sup> Avenue N.E.

Section 2. A public hearing shall be held upon the proposal to vacate the City right-of-way set forth in Section 1 on Monday, April 18, 2005 at the hour of 8:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 11511 Main Street, Bellevue, Washington.

Section 3. Notice of such hearing shall be provided and posted in the manner required by section 14.35.050 and .060 of the Bellevue City Code inviting interested persons to appear and be heard for or against the proposed vacation.

Section 4. This matter is referred to the City Manager or his designee for investigation and report, as necessary, at said public hearing.
