RESOLUTION NO. 728

*Meeting at City Hall
at 10:00 a.m. 1/28*

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, amending Resolution No. 724, passed on the 28 day of January, 1958, relating to its declaration of intention to order a local improvement for the construction of storm drainage sewers, catch basins and related improvements, and setting a time and place for hearing objections thereto.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3 of Resolution No. 724, passed by the City Council of the City of Bellevue on the 28 day of January, 1958, and which read as follows:

Section 3. That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council, or a Committee thereof, to be held in the Council Chambers in the City Hall (V.F.W. Building), Main Street at 100th Avenue Southeast, in the City of Bellevue at 8:00 o'clock p.m., on the 10 day of September, 1958, which time and place are hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said improvement and all objections thereto and for determining the method of payment of said improvement.

be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council, or a Committee thereof, to be held in the auditorium of the Bellevue Elementary School, 102nd Avenue N.E. at N.E. 4th Street, in the City of Bellevue at 8:00 o'clock p.m., on the 11 day of September, 1958, which time and place are hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said improvement and all objections thereto and for determining the method of payment of said improvement.
