

RESOLUTION NO. 733.

A RESOLUTION, declaring an intention to order a local improvement for the location, establishment and pavement of a street, setting forth the nature and extent thereof, setting a date for hearing objections and giving notice thereof.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the City Council to order the improvement of an area within the City of Bellevue, described as:

Beginning at the centerline of 92nd Ave. N.E. and the north line of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 30 T. 25 N., R. 5 E.W.M.; thence easterly along said north line to a point which lies ninety-five (95) feet easterly of the centerline of said 92nd Ave. N.E.; thence southerly on a line ninety-five (95) feet easterly of an parallel to the centerline of said 92nd Ave. N.E. to the centerline of N.E. 8th St.; thence westerly along the centerline of N.E. 8th St. to its intersection with the southerly produced west boundary of Lot 13 of Schafer's Replat of portion of Kenwood Park & Eastland Acre Tracts (Supplemental), recorded in Volume 41 of Plats Pages 36 and 37, Records of King County; thence northerly along a line one hundred-thirty-five (135) feet westerly of and parallel to the centerline of said 92nd Ave. N.E. to the north boundary of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 30, T. 25 N., R. 5 E.W.M.; thence easterly along said north line to the point of beginning.

Such improvement shall consist of grading, regrading, filling, compacting, surfacing and improving said street by paving the same with bituminous concrete pavement and the construction of Portland cement combined curb and gutter, including provision for necessary drainage, and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, all in accordance with plans and specifications to be submitted by the City Engineer for the improving of the following described streets:

All that part and portion of 92nd Avenue N.E., extending between the centerline of N.E. 8th Street and the north boundary of the city limits of the City of Bellevue, which is the north line of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 30 Township 25, North, Range 5 E.W.M;

all according to the plans, drawings and specifications prepared by the City Engineer.


Section 2. That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the City Council, or a committee thereof, to be held in the Council Chamber in the V.F.W. Building in the City of Bellevue, Washington, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., on the

13<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1958, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said proposed improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

Section 3. That the City Manager shall submit to the City Council at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.


Section 4. That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property liable therefor, as provided by law.
