

RESOLUTION NO. 759

A RESOLUTION relating to acquisition of a site for a civic center.

WHEREAS, the growth of population and the development of residential and business property within the City of Bellevue is resulting in a scarcity of adequate sites for the location and construction of municipal buildings in convenient and suitable locations and is resulting in rapidly soaring land values and prices for the acquisition of sites for such municipal buildings, and

WHEREAS, many citizens are willing to support the general obligation bond issue proposed by Ordinance No. 253 for the acquisition of a civic center site and site improvements if the City Council is committed to the use of the proceeds of the sale of such bonds to acquire a site of sufficient size to serve the City's future needs for municipal buildings and a civic center, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Council act promptly, following a favorable election on November 4, 1958, to acquire a site consisting of not less than ten acres, suitably located, as a site for the construction of civic buildings and a civic center from the proceeds of the sale of bonds, as authorized by Ordinance No. 253.
