

RESOLUTION NO. 760

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing on a petition to vacate a portion of Otto Phette Road (King County Road #966) within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of interested property owners for the vacation of a portion of Otto Phette Road (King County Road No. 966) in the City of Bellevue lying

northerly of a line parallel to and 40 feet northerly of the centerline of the Bellevue-Redmond Highway, between 120th Avenue N.E. and 122nd Avenue N.E. in the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 28, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington,

on the 25 day of Nov, 1958 at the hour of 8:05 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the Council at the City Hall in the V. F. W. Building on the corner of Main Street and 100th Avenue S. E.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
