RESOLUTION NO. 766

A RESOLUTION naming four City parks.

WHEREAS, the City has within recent months acquired four new City parks and recreation areas; and

WHEREAS, said parks have not yet been named, much community interest has been shown of late in the choice of names, a contest was conducted, and winning names selected; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The name of the park of approximately 10 acres west of N.E. Northrup Way, and between N.E. 32nd Street and N.E. 30th Street, shall be NORTHRUP PARK.

Section 2. The name of the park of approximately 10 acres west of 104th Ave. S.E., and between S.E. 18th Street and S.E. 20th Street, shall be KILLARNEY GLEN PARK.

Section 3. The name of the park of approximately 48 acres in the valley between Lake Washington Boulevard and 118th Avenue S.E., and between S.E. 18th Street and S.E. 22nd Street, shall be BELLEFIELDS PARK.

Section 4. The name of the park which contains the boat launching site, along the old Mercer Slough, 1000 feet north of the Sunset Highway, and east of Lake Washington Boulevard, shall be SWEYLOCKEN PARK.

PASSED by the City Council this 10th day of August, 1959, and signed in authentication of its passage this 14th day of September, 1959.
