A RESOLUTION, relating to a concession in Meydenbauer Park; authorizing the City to contract with Fred H. Bush for the furnishing and operation of a refreshment stand in Meydenbauer Park during the summers of 1959, 1960 and 1961.


WHEREAS, it is desirable during the summer for the citizens of the City to have available to them refreshments at Meydenbauer Park; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:


