RESOLUTION NO. 773

A RESOLUTION naming a City park.

WHEREAS, the City has recently leased from Mr. and Mrs. Charles W. Bovee land for a City park; and

WHEREAS, said park has not been named, and much community interest has been shown of late in the naming of City parks; and

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Charles W. Bovee have generously leased said park to the City for One Dollar (\$1.00) per year, and Mr. Bovee has performed numerous other acts of benefit to the City and our community; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The name of the park of approximately 4 acres between 108th Avenue N.E. and 110th Avenue N.E. at N.E. 15th Street, shall be BOVEE PARK.
