RESOLUTION NO. 778


A RESOLUTION adopting a preliminary budget and ordering the same filed.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the proposed budget heretofore submitted by the City Manager on the first Tuesday of September, 1959, having been considered in detail, the same is hereby adopted as the preliminary budget of the City of Bellevue.

Section 2. That the preliminary budget, as adopted by Section 1 above, shall be filed with the City Clerk and copies thereof made available to the public and that notice of hearing thereon for the purpose of fixing the final budget and making tax levies thereunder shall be published according to law.
