

RESOLUTION NO. 786

A RESOLUTION fixing time and place for hearing on a petition to vacate a portion of 114th Ave.

N.E. and N.E. 2nd St. within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of interested property owners for the vacation of a portion of 114th Ave. N.E. and N.E. 2nd St. in the City of Bellevue lying


- (a) within the limits of Blocks 1 and 2, Fir Creek addition, King County, Wash. and further described as follows:
- (a) 114th Ave. N.E. lying north of N.E. 2nd Street and,
  - (b) 114th Ave. N.E. lying south of N.E. 2nd Street and,
  - (c) that portion of N.E. 2nd St. lying East of the East line of P.S.H. #1 RE and a north south line 15' West of the Centerline of 114th Ave. N.E. all with the following exceptions:
- (a) Beginning at the S.W. corner of lot 21, blk 2, said plat thence N 10' thence W 40' thence South 10' thence East 40' to pt. of beg.
  - (b) Beginning at the N.W. corner of lot 7, blk 1 said plat thence W 40' thence S 10' thence E 40' thence N 10' to pt. of beg.

on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1959 at the hour of 8:00 P.M. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the Council at the City Hall in the V.F.W. Building on the corner of Main Street and 100th Ave. S.E.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing to speak for or against the granting of said petition.


Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
