

A RESOLUTION fixing a time and place for hearing on a petition to vacate a portion of _____

103rd Avenue N.E. within the City of Bellevue.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a public hearing be had upon the petition of interested property owners for the vacation of a portion of _____

103rd Avenue N.E. in the City of Bellevue lying:

The South 342.6 feet of the North 372.6 feet of that portion of 103rd Avenue N.E., lying in the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 25 North, Range 5 E.W.M.

on the 22nd day of December, 19 59 at the hour of 8:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the Council at the City Hall in the V. P. W. Building on the corner of Main Street and 100th Avenue S. E.

Section 2. That notice of such hearing be posted in the manner required by law inviting interested persons to appear at said hearing to speak for or against the granting of said petition.

Section 3. That the petition be referred to the City Manager for investigation and report at said hearing.
