RESOLUTION NO. 792

A RESOLUTION authorizing a special election on the question of an excess levy for the development of City parks.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. That at a special election to be held on March 8, 1960 in the City of Bellevue, Washington, and in the various precincts thereof, the following proposition and question shall be voted upon by the qualified voters or electors of said city, to-wit:

PROPOSITION NO. 1
"EXCESS LEVY FOR PARK DEVELOPMENT"

Shall the City Council of the City of Bellevue be authorized to levy a special property tax in the year 1960 for receipt in the year 1961 in the approximate amount of One mill, sufficient to raise the sum of \$ 19,342.00 to be paid into the Park Fund of the City of Bellevue, for the purpose of developing the existing City parks, including the construction of play areas, parking areas, and picnic facilities, said millage being in excess of any constitutional or statutory authority?
