

RESOLUTION NO. 795

A RESOLUTION of the City Council of the City of Bellevue reaffirming policy favoring construction of a second bridge crossing of Lake Washington at the Montlake-Evergreen Point location and commending officials.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that:

WHEREAS, the continual development and expansion of the City of Bellevue and the Eastside is directly related to rapid highway facilities with the City of Seattle; and

WHEREAS, a second bridge crossing north of the present bridge is compatible with the comprehensive street plan of the City of Bellevue; and


WHEREAS, former councils of the City of Bellevue have resolved that a northerly crossing would best serve the interest of Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, traffic congestion on the present Lake Washington bridge is critical and injurious to the welfare of the eastside communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Bellevue, hereby pronounces that it is the policy of this city to encourage the immediate construction of a second bridge crossing of Lake Washington at the Montlake-Evergreen Point location upon determination of financing legality by court decision and to render such assistance as may be commensurate with statutory authority; and that

The City Council of the City of Bellevue do hereby commend the officials of the State of Washington and County of King in their efforts to resolve the complex problem of financing a northerly bridge at Montlake-Evergreen Point.
