A RESOLUTION naming Norton Boulevard.

WHEREAS, the plats of Newport and Newport Revised Division No. 1, contain a circular street consisting of four segments, and each segment has a different name; and

WHEREAS, it is felt that one circular street consisting of four separately named segments would be confusing to the public; and


WHEREAS, a portion of the area covered by said circular street has been replatted, thus necessitating the change of names on the two plats aforementioned; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The streets on the plat of Newport, King County, Washington, designated 118th Avenue S.E., S.E. 48th Street, 112th Avenue S.E., and S.E. 42nd Street, are hereby renamed NORTON BOULEVARD.

Section 2. The streets on the plat of Newport Revised Division No. 1, King County, Washington, designated S.E. 48th Street, 112th Avenue S.E., and S.E. 42nd Street, are hereby renamed NORTON BOULEVARD.


