RESOLUTION NO. 810

A RESOLUTION regarding L.I.D. No. 59-S-13 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E., from Main Street to N. E. 8th Street.

WHEREAS, a petition for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 8th Street has been received by the Clerk and the Council; and has been referred to the Engineer for checking as to sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer and Council have found the petition sufficient, and the Council has directed the Engineer to prepare the estimated cost of the job and the estimated amounts of the individual assessments; and

WHEREAS, the Council has now received the Engineer's estimate of the total cost of the job and of the estimated amounts of the individual assessments; now therefore


BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The petition for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 8th Street, received under Clerk's receiving number 349, be and the same is hereby accepted; further, that said petition is found to be sufficient.

Section 2. The Engineer's estimate of the total cost of the job in the amount of \$ 342,235.47, and of the estimated amount of the individual assessments, received under Clerk's receiving number 381 (1-3), be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 3. Upon passage of the ordinance ordering the improvement, the Engineer shall prepare the detailed plans and specifications for the improvement.
