

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 826

A RESOLUTION regarding the placement of portions of 104th Avenue and Lake Washington Boulevard S.E. on the State Highway System; and supporting the resolution of the Lake Washington Good Roads Association to that effect.

WHEREAS there is urgent need for a four and six lane road from U.S. Highway No. 10 northerly to the proposed intersection of 104th Avenue N.E. and the approach road to the Evergreen Point Bridge; and

WHEREAS said section of road is now owned by King County and the City of Bellevue, with the State maintaining certain sections immediately north of U.S. Highway No. 10; now therefore


BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. That the State of Washington be requested to place 104th Avenue and Lake Washington Boulevard, from U.S. Highway No. 10 north to the intersection of 104th Avenue N.E. with the approach road to the Evergreen Point Bridge, on the State Highway System at the earliest possible time to insure free movement of traffic from the densely populated areas in Bellevue to the approach road for the Evergreen Point Bridge.

Section 2. That the City of Bellevue, King County and State of Washington share the expense of the improvement as shall be mutually agreed upon between the three governmental agencies, and that the next session of the Legislature be asked to pass the necessary legislation authorizing such action.


Section 3. That the City Council does hereby support the resolution of the Lake Washington Good Roads Association to the same effect, which resolution will be presented at the forthcoming meeting of the Washington State Good Roads Convention at Yakima.
