RESOLUTION NO. 829

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 59-S-13 for the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E.


WHEREAS the City Council did on May 24, 1960, pass Ordinance No. 359, ordering the improvement of 106th Avenue N.E., from Main Street to N.E. 8th Street, and creating Local Improvement District No. 59-S-13 therefor; and

WHEREAS expenses have now been incurred by the City in connection with said L.I.D., and claims have been presented to the City therefor, to-wit: Joseph S. Miller, legal costs, \$161.65; Bellevue-American, publication \$77.96; Washington Title Insurance Co., Condemnation Certificate, \$70.00; Fred Darnell, Sr., appraisal, \$650.00; and Daily Journal of Commerce, publication, \$48.00; a total of \$1,007.61; and it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:


Section 1. That the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of Local Improvement District warrants in the amount of \$1,007.61 to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Southwick Campbell Waterman Co., contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
