RESOLUTION NO. 836

A RESOLUTION regarding the placement of utility lines in undeveloped areas of the City.

WHEREAS there are certain undeveloped areas in the City in which the utility lines have not yet been installed; and

WHEREAS it is desired that such areas when finally developed be fine, modern, business or residential areas; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council will use and exert its best efforts to cause the appropriate utility companies who may hereafter install any lines for the transmission of power, energy or communications in undeveloped areas, such as along 196th Avenue N.E. between N.E. 6th Street and N.E. 8th Street, to plan such installations in conjunction with the City, and to enclose such lines underground.
