A RESOLUTION supporting passage of the
Model State Fireworks Law.

except in supervised public displays, will be introduced in
the 37th Session of the Washington State Legislature; now
therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
Bellevue, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. That the Council does hereby go on record
as supporting the passage of the bill to outlaw the sale and
use of fireworks, except in supervised public displays, and
known as the Model State Fireworks Law.
