RESOLUTION NO. 892

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 61-S-15 for the improvement of a portion of N.E. 2nd Street.

WHEREAS the City Council did on May 9, 1961, pass Ordinance No. 442, ordering the improvement of N.E. 2nd Street from 104th Avenue N.E. to 108th Avenue N.E., and creating Local Improvement District No. 61-S-15 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

AND WHEREAS additional costs have accrued for the purchase of right-of-way, and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of *Forty-two Thousand Two Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$42,230.00)* to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Southwick, Campbell, Waterman Co., contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
