RESOLUTION NO. 946

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 62-S-28 for the improvement of portions of N.E. 6th Street and 110th Avenue N.E.

WHEREAS the City Council did on June 12, 1962, pass Ordinance No. 532 for the improvement of N.E. 6th Street from 108th Avenue N.E. to 112th Avenue N.E., plus 110th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 6th Street to a point 215 feet south of the centerline of N.E. 8th Street, and creating Local Improvement District No. 62-S-28 therefor; and

AND WHEREAS costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of Two Thousand Sixty-seven Dollars and Sixty-six Cents (\$2,067.66) to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Southwick, Campbell, Waterman Co., contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
