RESOLUTION NO. 947

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 61-S-15 for the improvement of a portion of N.E. 2nd Street.

WHEREAS the City Council did on May 9, 1961, pass Ordinance No. 442 ordering the improvement of N.E. 2nd Street from 104th Avenue N.E. to 108th Avenue N.E., and creating Local Improvement District No. 61-S-15 therefor; and

WHEREAS a petition has been filed by the City in the Superior Court of the State of Washington for King County "--to acquire by condemnation certain property and property rights for N.E. 2nd Street, between 104th Avenue N.E. and 108th Avenue N.E., as contemplated in Ordinance No. 442"; that said matter was assigned docket number 577957; that on July 10, 1962, a Judgment and Decree of Condemnation was entered therein awarding judgment to the following individuals in the amounts shown:
