RESOLUTION NO. 948

A RESOLUTION regarding the annexation
of contiguous unincorporated territory.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council does hereby determine that the best interests and general welfare of the City of Bellevue would be served by the annexation of the following-described unincorporated territory which is contiguous to the City of Bellevue:

Beginning from the intersection of the southerly right of way of Primary State Highway No. 2 and the west line of the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 11, Twsp. 24 N, R 5 E., W.M.; thence southerly along said east line to the north line of Section 14, Twsp. 24 N, R 5 E., W.M.; thence continuing southerly along the west line of the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 14 to its intersection with the center line of the Newport Issaquah Rd.; thence westerly along the center line of said Newport Issaquah Rd. to its intersection with the east line of the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 14; thence southerly along said east line to the north line of the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 14; thence westerly along said north line to the east line of Section 15, Twsp. 24 N., R 5 E., W.M.; thence northerly along said east line to its intersection with the center line of Newport Issaquah Rd.; thence westerly along the center line of said Newport-Issaquah Rd. to its intersection with the east line of Section 16, Twsp. 24 N, R 5 E., W.M.; thence southerly along the east line of said Section 16 to the north east corner of Section 21, Twsp. 24 N, R 5 E, W.M.; thence continuing southerly along the east line of said Section 21 to the north line of the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 21; thence westerly along the said north line to the east line of Section 20, Twsp. 24 N, R 5 E., W.M.; thence continuing westerly along the north line of the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 20 to its intersection with the Inner Harbor line in Lake Washington; thence northerly along said Inner Harbor line to the southerly City Limits of the City of Bellevue as defined in City of Bellevue Ordinance No. 397 and revised in City of Bellevue Ordinance No. 416; thence easterly and northerly along the southerly and easterly City Limits of the City of Bellevue as defined in said Ordinances No. 397 and No. 416 and as also defined in City of Bellevue Ordinances No. 223 and No. 213, to the intersection of said easterly City Limit with the southerly right of way line of Primary State Highway No. 2; thence easterly along the said southerly right of way line to the true point of beginning.

Section 2. That, as nearly as may be, the number of voters residing in the aforesaid territory is 4200.

Section 3. The City Council does hereby pray that the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington, call an election to be held among the qualified voters in the aforesaid territory upon the question of annexation.

Section 4. That the cost of said annexation election shall be paid by the City of Bellevue.


Section 5. That a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington, in which county said territory is located.
