RESOLUTION NO. 952

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 61-S-21 for the improvement of the Bellevue-Redmond Road.

WHEREAS the City Council did on April 10, 1962, pass Ordinance No. 515 ordering the improvement of N.E. 8th Street from 116th Avenue N.E. to 120th Avenue N.E., Plus Bellevue-Redmond Road from N.E. 8th Street to 120th Avenue N.E., and the northwesterly portion of the Bellevue-Redmond Road, from 120th Avenue N.E. to 132nd Avenue N.E., and creating Local Improvement District No. 61-S-21 therefor; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrant No. 1, dated June 29, 1962 \$15,363.89

WHEREAS the City Manager has, in writing and under date of July 24, 1962, approved and recommended payment to Pacific Paving Company in the additional sum of \$48,227.20; and


AND WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of \$50,305.78 to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Terry Thompson and Company, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
