A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 61-S-21 for the improvement of the Bellevue-Redmond Road.

WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

WHEREAS the City Engineer has, in writing and under date of August 20, 1962, approved and recommended payment to Pacific Paving Company in the additional sum of \$33,556.63;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of \$33,556.63 to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Terry Thompson and Company, contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.
