A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No. 62-S-28 for the improvement of portions of N.E. 6th Street and 110th Avenue N.E.

WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the above-entitled public works project; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants have previously been issued as follows:

Warrants No. 1 through 3, dated July 30, 1962 \$2,067.66

WHEREAS the City Engineer has, in writing and under date of August 24, 1962, approved and recommended payment to Bellevue Bulldozing, Inc. in the sum of \$5,327.80; and

WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been presented by the following:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bellevue that the administrative personnel and proper officials, for and on behalf of the City of Bellevue, Washington, proceed with the issuance of local improvement district warrants in the amount of \$5,333.56 to bear interest in accordance with the bid and contract of Southwick, Campbell, Waterman Co., contract purchaser of the warrants and bonds in the financing of said project.


