RESOLUTION NO. 981

A RESOLUTION in regard to L.I.D. No.
62-S-28 for the improvement of portions
of N.E. 6th Street and 110th Avenue N.E.

WHEREAS a contract has been let for the construction of the
above-entitled public works project; and

WHEREAS said project has progressed and L.I.D. revenue warrants
have previously been issued as follows:

Warrants No. 1 through 3, dated July 30, 1962	\$2,067.66
Warrant No. 4, dated September 6, 1962	5,333.56
Warrant No. 5, dated October 1, 1962	869.73

AND WHEREAS the City Engineer has, in writing and under date of
November 5, 1962, approved and recommended payment to Bellevue Bull-
dozing, Inc., the sum of \$10,672.60; and


WHEREAS additional costs have accrued and claims have been
presented by the following:

Minish-Webb & Associates, September 16 to October 11, 1962, field staking and survey work	185.22
Minish-Webb & Associates, period ending September 15th, field staking	688.96

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to issue L.I.D. warrants in payment
thereof;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
