RESOLUTION NO. 991

A RESOLUTION relating to the 1962 Budget; and authorizing expenditures from funds received in excess of estimated revenues in 1962.

WHEREAS the City received \$4,706 from property owners for contributions for the improvement of streets, \$1,085 for the improvement of culverts, and \$225 for street restoration; together with the sum of \$284 from King County for the prorating of road taxes for annexed areas; and

WHEREAS the funds so received were not anticipated at the time of the preparation of the 1962 Budget; and

WHEREAS it is to the best interests of the City that such excess revenues be appropriated as hereinafter recited; Now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 1962 Budget Ordinance No. 470, approved by the City Council on the 2nd day of October, 1961, and all amendments thereto, is hereby amended by appropriating the funds received from sources not anticipated as hereinbefore recited, and the same are hereby budgeted by increasing the following item:
